



# Change Your Air Filter

If you don't change your air filter, it can quickly become clogged with dust and debris, preventing proper air filtration. This leads to a variety of issues for your HVAC system including system inefficiency, higher energy bill, inadequate air quality, and ultimately failure of your HVAC system.

Clogged and dirty air filters require your HVAC system to work harder to push air through the system.



***Be sure and change your air filter  
in each unit every 30 days.***

- Replacing your air filters is considered routine home maintenance and not covered under your one-year builder warranty.
- Failure to replace dirty air filters can also impact your unit's manufacturer warranty.
- Never run your HVAC unit without a filter.
